When elegance is required

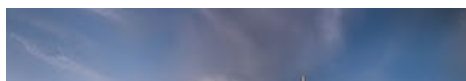

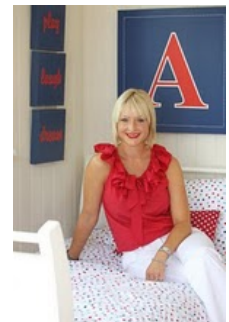


